Section of N. Mills Street to close to traffic

Posted on October 30, 2018

N. Mills Street between University Avenue and W. Johnson Street will soon close to two-way through traffic for approximately three weeks. The closure is part of utility work for the Chemistry Building expansion project. The closure date is tentatively planned for mid-next week (week of November 5); stay tuned for more details. Updates will be posted here as they become available.

Vehicle access will be available to Conklin Place from University Avenue. As <u>Charter Street is also closed</u> between University Avenue and W. Johnson Street, motorists should detour using N. Orchard Street, N. Park Street, N. Randall Avenue, or another parallel street.

The Metro Transit bus stops along this section of N. Mills Street will close during the project. Routes 4, 13, 27, and 44 will be affected. When a closure date is set, <u>Metro's website</u> will post detailed detour information.

The east side N. Mills Street sidewalk will be open, but the west sidewalk will be closed. Pedestrians should be advised: access to the Chemistry Building at the building's northeast corner is closed, but open on the south.

A map of all construction projects and detours can be found on the <u>campus parking maps page</u>. Project dates may change due to weather conditions or other factors.
