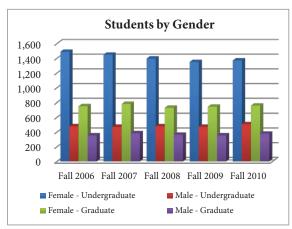

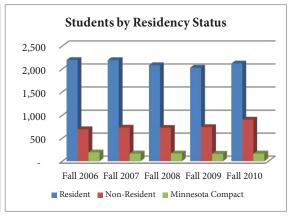

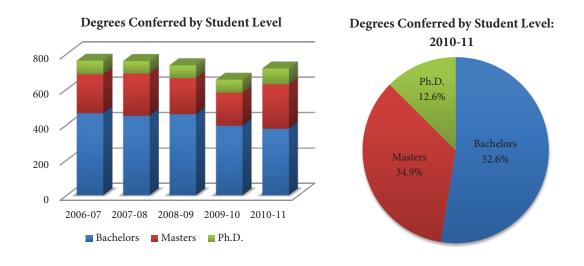

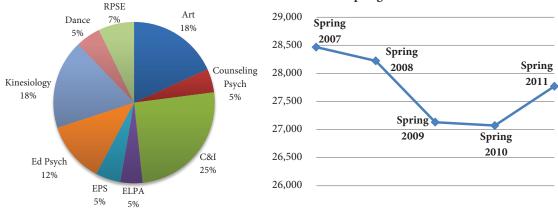

Credits by Department Spring SoE Credits Trend



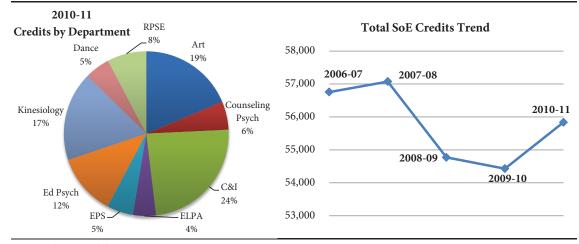

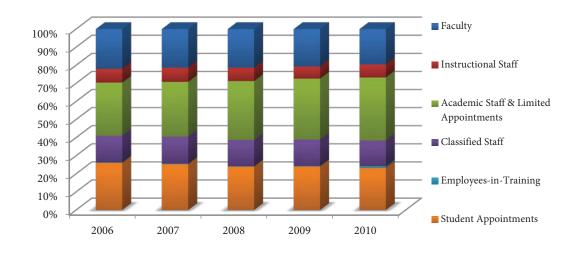

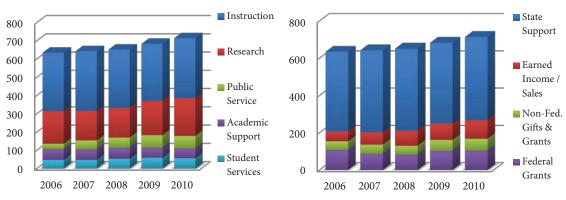

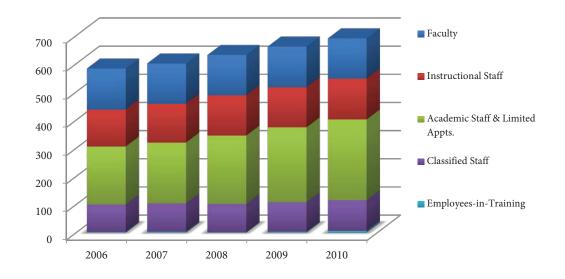
