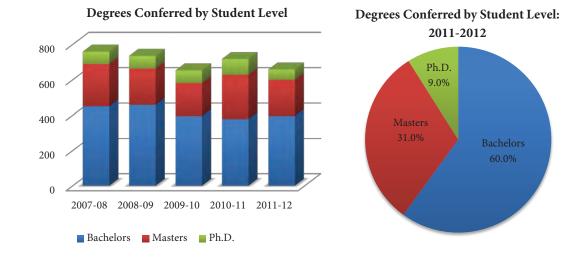

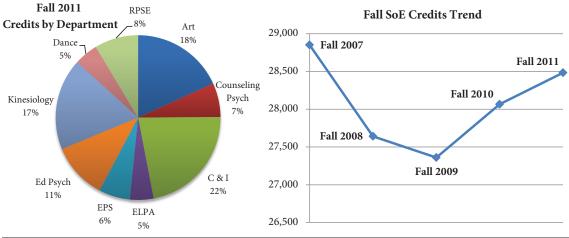

Credit Production by Department - Fall Semesters



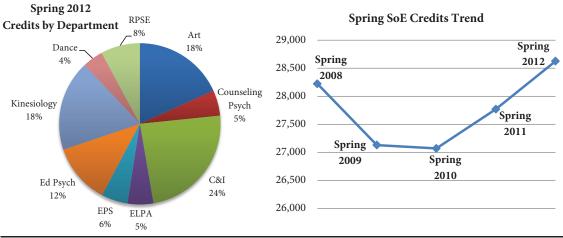

Credit Production by Department - Spring Semesters



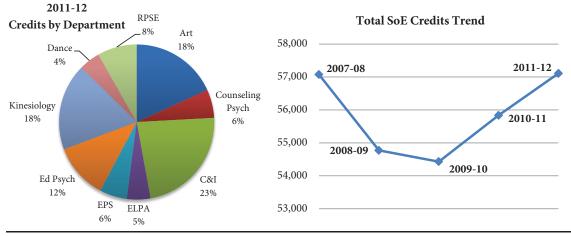

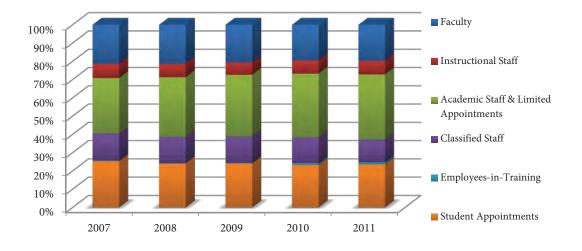

FTE by Employee Category*



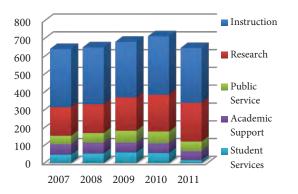

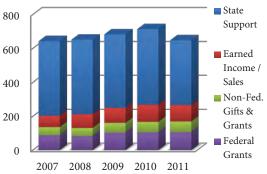

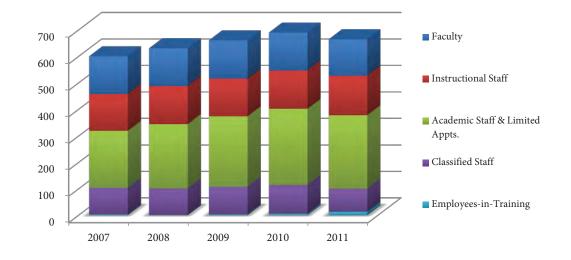

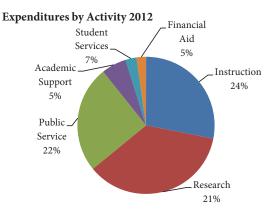
